Counseling

Engage in holistic healing with masterlevel therapists trained in trauma and crisis counseling, plus mental health support.

Support Groups

Feel welcomed in a safe space of understanding and support facilitated by master-level therapists.

Healing



Child Play Therapy

Early intervention and specialized therapy techniques for children who have experienced or witnessed abuse.

Freedom



Case Management

Work toward concrete goals like housing and job security with a case manager well-versed in community resources.

Shelter

Access comprehensive wrap-around services in safe and comfortable emergency and transitional shelters staffed 24/7 by trauma-informed advocates.

Youth Services

Includes childcare and youth services while living in the shelter, led by licensed staff who model healthy relationships and facilitate social and emotional learning.

Financial Empowerment

Regain confidence and learn the skills to plan for your future.
